# Snip & Stitch



Jalie 3461 Eleonore Stretch pull on jeans

**Brief Description of Class:** In this class students will learn how to make the Eleonore stretch pull on jeans. In the prep class they will choose the right size, trace out the pattern, and address some of the fitting possibilities. They will cut out the fabric at home and construct them in the second class. Some of the skills covered will be working with stretch fabrics, seam choices, sewing the mock fly and mock front pockets, adding back patch pockets, constructing the pants to the elastic waist, and finishing techniques with some embellishment options.

<b>SUPPLY LIST</b>	
<b>Pattern:</b> Jalie 3461	<b>Our Part #:JALIE</b>
Pattern tracing paper to trace out the pattern, scissors	
Pencil and ruler for tracing, fabric marker	
Tape measure, pins	
Press cloth	
Stretch needle for machine	
Sergers if you have one, but options given for regular machine construction	
Fabric according to your size on pattern, choose by hip measurement. I recommend buying sale fabric for the first pair so that alterations can be made before you make your perfect pair. Be sure that the fabric meets the stretch test on the back of pattern. Be sure to check the width of your fabric. Some of them are not 60" wide	
1" elastic(.9m-1.3m listed on back of pattern)	
Thread, polyester or cotton to match fabric and to topstitch with	

Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order. Bring full accessories & manual for machine.

Homework prior to class (if applicable): No machines for the first class. We will be working on the patterns. Bring everything for the 2<sup>nd</sup> one.
