**Come learn all about trim in place in-the-hoop appliqué, full scale templates and multi-hooping to make a delightful topper called *Sweet Tranquility* designed by Jenice Belling. For all brands of embroidery machines with a 200 X 280 hoop or larger.**

<b>SUPPLIES</b>	<b>Our Part #</b>
Combo sewing/embroidery machine or embroidery only machine, power cord, table and all accessories, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Embroidery Hoop 200 X 280 or larger</li> <li>• Embroidery Hoop 130 X 180 (optional but nice to have)</li> <li>• USB Stick: Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.</li> </ul>	
Pattern: <b>Sweet Tranquility</b>	<b>OGD144</b>  
1.0 m background fabric	
1.0 m backing	
0.8 m binding (cut on bias)	
0.5 m green for stems and leaves

<b>SUPPLIES</b>	<b>Our Part #</b>
0.2 or fat quarters for appliqué	
36 inch square batting	
2.0 m Wonder Under Fusible web	
Unscented Mary Ellen's Best Press	
Mini Iron and Pressing surface	
Machine embroidery threads to coordinate with appliqué fabrics	
Decobob or pre-wounds	
Inspira Tear Away Stabilizer	
505 Temporary Spray	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	
Havel's Snip-Eze scissors for trimming the appliqué fabrics in the hoop.	
Eyelet punch	
Removable fabric marker that will show up on your fabric.	
Paper scissors or old rotary cutter blade, write-on scotch tape and pencil	
Rotary Cutter, 6 X 12 ruler and mat	
Basic Sewing supplies: seam ripper, pins, etc.	

### **PRE-CLASS PREPARATION**

Please, note: The topper is slightly smaller (about 34 inches) than the pattern. Maximum hoop size required this slight adjustment. At the most, in the two day retreat, you can expect to finish all of the embroidery hoopings. You will need to complete the project on your own or sign up for a Machine Embroidery Software Cafe if you require help to finish.

Please take the time to spray and iron all fabrics with Mary Ellen's Unscented Best Press before class. Spray and iron twice, to ensure fabrics are crisp and shrinkage is removed.

Do not trace any of the appliqué patterns onto your fusible web. This is not necessary when completing a project that is a "trim in place appliqué design". Purchase of the pattern is a requirement for copy write reasons.
