<p>Janome 500E, and power cord.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Table • Contents of Acufil Quilting Kit for Janome 500E (please pre-order as soon as possible to be sure your kit arrives before class): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ ASQ hoop and heavy plastic template with magnets • USB stick 	
<p>18 ½ inch square light coloured fabric for center Two 6 ½ X 18 ½ inch dark strips for side borders Two 6 ½ X 31 inch dark strips for top and bottom borders 35 inch square batting 35 inch square backing fabric Four 2 inch X width of fabric for binding</p> <p>See instructions on the next page for preparing this small quilt BEFORE you come to class.</p>	
<p>Neutral colour thread for piecing</p>	
<p>Thread for quilting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consider using a Sulky Blendable or other variegated thread – one that will show up on the light coloured fabric and one that will compliment your border fabric. • The same thread is used in the bobbin as well as on top 	
<p>Extra empty bobbins</p>	
<p>Janome Blue and Red tip embroidery needles</p>

Safety Pins for basting quilt sandwich	
Measuring tape	
Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, Scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins, thread, thread snips, wash away fabric marker that will show up on your fabric.	

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

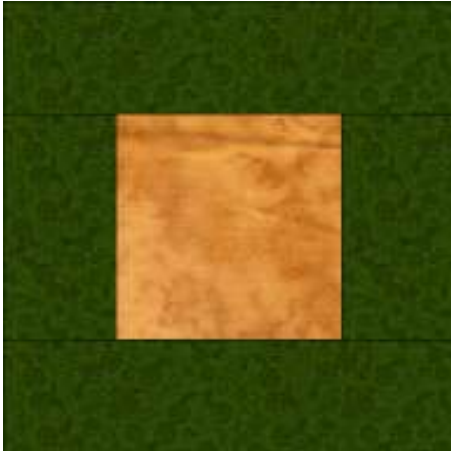
You must sew your table topper together and sandwich with batting and backing before you arrive!

To accommodate hooping, borders are cut wider than finished border width.

Sew the 6 ½ inch X 18 ½ inch border strips to opposite sides of the 18 ½ in square. Press seams to the borders



Sew the 6 ½ inch X 31 inch border strips to the top and bottom. Press seams to the borders.



Sandwich top with batting and backing. To accommodate hooping, the batting and backing have been sized 4 – 5 inches larger than the top.

Use a little 505 Temporary Spray to hold then use several safety pins to baste.
