Creative description of the class including the objective of the class/what will the student learn?: Students taking this class will make samples of different binding techniques. Included are basic double fold French binding, how to turn the corners, how to finish the ends, how to bind by machine invisibly and with decorative blanket stitch, curved bindings, and how to make a facing instead.

Pattern or book:

Jeans80 or microtex 80, and topstitch needles	
¼" steam a seam, small square ruler	
Hand needles, ruler, cutter, mat	
Cotton, invisible, and Sulky Blendable thread	
2 fat ¼"s of fabric and a piece of batting the same size. Prequilt these together and bring to class	
walking, clear or open toe foot	

Bring machine in good working order with manual. Bring basic supplies: scissors, pins, seam ripper, fabric marker of choice.

!!! Preclass Homework: Make sure to quilt your fat ¼'s together and bring to class. We want to spend the class binding not quilting. Cathy will supply fabric for all the bindings.
