PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

Space in the classroom is limited. Please ensure you prepare your fabric at home.

• Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to press fabric for embroidery at home. Spray and iron dry 2 or 3 times. This takes the "shrink" out of the fabric and will will improve the quality of your embroidery stitchout.
