# Snip & Stitch



Bias Wave Runner

**Brief Description of Class:** In this class students will learn how to channel quilt a table runner with a walking foot. When the quilting is completed then students will make their own fusible bias tape using bias tape makers and apply them to the quilted background. Binding completes it.

SUPPLY LIST	
<b>Pattern/Book:</b> Cathy will supply the pattern included in class	<b>Our Part #:</b>
1.2m background, backing, and binding fabric	
2, .5m or fat quarters of fabric for the bias tape(I recommend batiks for this but especially for the skinny strips)	
1/4" Steam A Seam on the roll	
1/4" and 1/2" clover bias makers	
Cotton thread to match background	
Jeans 80 needle for quilting	
Walking foot	
Monofilament thread to blend with bias tape fabrics(clear for lights, smoke for darks)	
Ruler, cutter, mat	
Microtex 70 needle for applying the bias strips	
Fabric marker that will show on background	

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, Scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins, thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice
