Dripping Diamonds Quilt Top

Brief Description of Class: Using the book, The Big Book of Lap Quilts, students will learn how to make the Dripping Diamonds quilt top. Skills include organizing strip sets, sewing and pressing those strip sets, cutting 60 degree diamonds with a long ruler, laying out the project, sewing the diagonal rows with inset triangles, squaring up, adding a decorative narrow flange, adding the outer border, and discussion of quilting and finishing the project. This book will be used for other classes as well.

SUPPLY LIST	
Book: The Big Book of Lap Quilts	Our Part #: B1488
Ruler for cutting, needs to have a 60 degree line on it and be at least 8" wide. The 8 ½" x 24" Omnigrid is recommended.	
Cutter and mat	
Fabrics: 1 jelly roll or cut 39, 2 ½" strips width of fabric for the diamonds. .8m of setting triangle fabric, .3m of flange fabric, 1.8m outer border fabric, .6m binding fabric	
67" x 79" batting and backing	
Scissors, pins, seam ripper	
Optional, mary ellen best press unscented to stabilize the diamond blocks	
Cotton thread for piecing, and jeans 80/12 for the machine	
Large flannel sheet or fuzzy backed plastic tablecloth to do the layout on	

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine

Homework prior to class (if applicable): If you are using yardage for the strips you can start cutting the 2 ½" strips at home.
