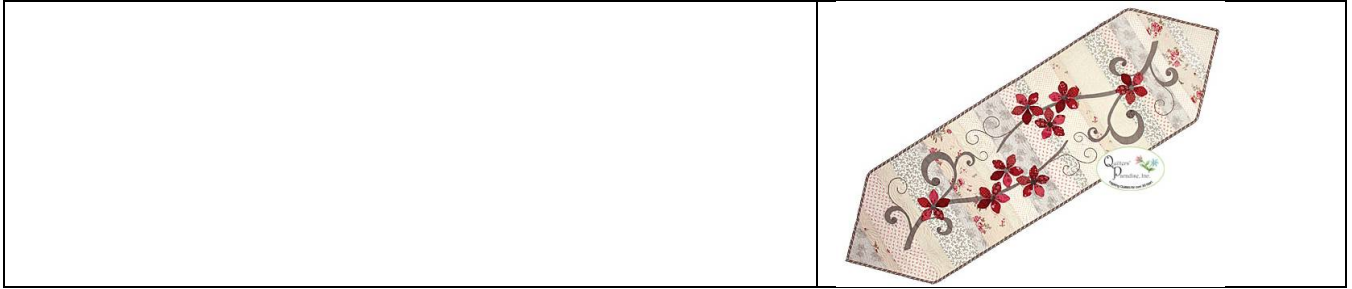

The Flourish Table Runner by Colette Belt with digitized appliqué embroidery designs by Donna M is a great project for those wanting to learn all about multi-hooping and in-the hoop appliqué. After piecing the background, you will use a full-scale template to mark the start of the embroidery design. You will use the traditional trim in place technique appliqué technique used by many digitizers for in the hoop appliqué designs. Quilting the completed runner will also be discussed. Minimum hoop size for this project is 200 X 280 mm.

<p>Combo Sewing Embroidery Machine with minimum hoop size of 200 X 280 or sewing machine and stand alone embroidery machine with minimum hoop size of 200 X 280 and usual embroidery supplies including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hoop(s) – e-mail me with the make and model of your machine and I will confirm which hoop you must bring for class • Power Cord • Foot control (for sewing the top) • USB stick. Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one. • Embroidery foot

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0.3 m of 6 different fabric for background or 6 fat quarters	
0.4 m fabric for branch	
0.2 m fabric for flower petals or scraps of 5-8 prints.	
Scrap for flower centers	
0.3 m fabric for binding	
1.8 m fabric for backing	
20 X 65 piece batting (0.5 m of 90 inch wide batting)	
2.0 m Wonder Under Fusible web	
Machine embroidery thread to coordinate with appliqué fabrics	
Decobob or pre-wounds	
Inspira Tear Away Stabilizer	
505 Temporary Spray	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class please)	
Bobbins	
Construction thread for piecing	
Quilting thread	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	
Fabric marker that will show up on your fabric (test before use to make sure you can remove it)	
Paper scissors or old rotary cutter blade	
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat	
Seam Ripper	
Thread snips	
Eyelet cutter	
Scotch tape	
¼ inch foot	
Walking foot	

We'll be cutting and piecing the top, preparing your fabrics for in the hoop appliqué and preparing your positioning template in the morning, on the first day. In the afternoon we will hopefully have time to start the embroidery process.
