# THIS SUPPLY LIST CONTAINS IMPORTANT PREP-CLASS INFORMATION. THERE ARE THREE PAGES PLEASE READ ALL THE WAY TO THE END.

Donna has designed this lovely quilt using the collection from <a href="http://www.janome-embroidery.com">http://www.janome-embroidery.com</a> called *Garden Grace*. Learn all about multi-hooping to create the individual blocks. This is a quilt as you go technique and each block is quilted using a circle stitcher attachment before sewing the blocks together with the sashing and border. Use decorative stitches to embellish and quilt the sashing and border and then add a two colour binding to finish this "no hand sewing at all" quilt. For those with a minimum hoop size of 200 X 200. For all brands of embroidery machines.

### DO NOT BRING YOUR MACHINE TO THE PREP CLASS.

The prep class will be devoted to preparing positioning templates for each of the 9 blocks.

I will go over the instructions for pre-cutting your fabric in preparation for embroidery at the first full day class.

I will review the supply list so everyone understands what they need to bring to each class, including the hoops you will require.

We will also review the time-line of the class.

**Please bring** a rotary cutter with an old blade, 16 X 24 rotary cutting mat, 6 X 24 inch ruler, pencil and scotch tape.

Also bring paper and a pen or pencil for note taking. You might find a small binder with sheet protectors useful for keeping all your handouts together.
