**“Hearts Afire” by Smith Street Designs is an appliqué pattern for embroidery machines that is very versatile! The designs combine to create a large quilt, or you can combine individual blocks with other quilt block layouts to create smaller projects. This class will focus on making a Long Bed or Table Runner. Donna has prepared two options for you to choose from. Appliqué pieces can be pre-cut using cutwork needles, scissors or a digital cutter. Designs are also prepared for use with the Tack and Trim method as well. Minimum hoop size is 130 X 180. For the confident beginner.**

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<p>Fabric Requirements will be discussed at the prep class. The following should be used as a guide only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1.0 m light fabric for embroidery background and binding</li> <li>• 0.3 rose fabric for piecing</li> <li>• 0.5 m burgundy for piecing and binding</li> <li>• 1.0 m dark green for embroidery background and borders</li> <li>• 0.2 m deep red for appliqué</li> <li>• 0.4 m pink for appliqué and binding</li> <li>• 0.5 m green for appliqué</li> <li>• 0.2 m dark plum for appliqué</li> <li>• 0.2 light plum for appliqué</li> <li>• 1.5 m fabric for backing</li> <li>• 0.8 m 90 inch wide batting</li> </ul>

<p>PRE-CUT with Cutwork Needles Method:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cutwork Needles</li> <li>• Tear Away Stabilizer</li> <li>• Terial Magic to stiffen fabric</li> <li>• Heat N Bond Lite fusible web Wonder Under Fusible Web, mini iron and portable pressing surface, or Fabric Glue Stick if you prefer to omit the fusible web</li> </ul>	
<p>PRE-CUT with Silhouette Cameo Cutter or Edge Cutter Method</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Laptop computer with latest version of your cutter software loaded.</li> <li>• Terial Magic or Mary Ellen's Best Press to stiffen fabric</li> <li>• Appliqué Pressing Sheet</li> <li>• Heat N Bond Lite fusible web or Wonder Under fusible web, mini iron and portable pressing surface, or Fabric Glue Stick if you prefer to omit the fusible web</li> <li>• Cutter, power cord, usb cable, mat, fabric blade(s)</li> </ul>	

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<p>PRE-CUT by Hand with Scissors Method</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Heat N Bond EZ Print sheets saves tracing by hand with a pencil or marker</li> <li>• Sharp scissors</li> <li>• Mini iron and portable pressing surface</li> </ul>	
<p>TACK &amp; TRIM Method:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fabric Glue Stick or Fusible Web</li> <li>• Small, sharp, curved embroidery scissors</li> </ul>

Mini Iron and Pressing Surface	
Machine embroidery threads to coordinate/contrast with appliqué fabrics	
Light weight machine embroidery bobbin thread or pre-wounds	
505 Temporary Spray	
Inspira Tear Away Stabilizer

Janome Blue and Red tip needles	
Paper scissors or rotary cutter with old blade	
Write on scotch tape

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, Scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins, thread, thread snips, wash away fabric marker that will show up on your fabric.

DO NOT BRING YOUR MACHINE TO THE PREP CLASS.

This class has several options for preparing appliqué shapes and 2 projects to choose from. The purpose of the prep class is for me to find out what method for preparing appliqué shapes you are using and which project you are making. Once I know that, I can advise each of you on what you need in the way of supplies and what you need to get ready for the first full day class.

Please bring with you your purchased **Hearts Afire** embroidery CD, note taking materials, a usb stick and any fabrics you are thinking of using.
