Brief Description of Class: Students in this class will make the Hexagon Garden quilt top. Skills include making and pressing strip sets, organizing them, cutting 60 degree triangles, doing a layout, sewing triangular rows, trimming the edges up, and adding the outer border. Quilting and finishing techniques will be discussed. Fall in love with triangular piecing.

SUPPLY LIST	
Pattern:Hexagon Garden	Our Part #:QR111
Fabrics, 1 jelly roll or 40, 2 ½” strips cut the width of fabric. The more fabrics the better, choose lights, mediums, and darks. .5m for border, and .5m for binding.	
Batting and backing 59” x 61” sample used Fireside for the backing	
Cotton thread for piecing	
Jeans 80/12 needle for machine	
Ruler, cutter, cutting mat	
Creative Grids 60 degree ruler at least 6 ½” high	
Fuzzy backed plastic tablecloth to use as a design layout board	

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, Scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins, thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.

Homework prior to class (if applicable):If cutting your own strips, please cut at least a few before the first class so we can build some blocks.
