Make some stylish accessories to store your needed tools and blocks. Hoopsisters has designed a Block Tote to carry your blocks to class. Also a handy sleeve case to protect your Trimmer by George 2.0 and a matching rotary cutter case. All the piecing and quilting is done in the hoop! Class fee includes all hand outs and embroidery designs. Most brands of machine the minimum hoop size is 200 X 200 mm.

<p>Combo Sewing/Embroidery Machine or Sewing Machine and Stand Alone Embroidery Machine with standard presser foot and usual embroidery supplies including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200 X 200 mm or larger Hoop • Power Cord • Foot control (for sewing the top) • USB stick. Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one. • Embroidery foot
