


PLEASE READ ALL THE WAY TO THE END.**

Donna has digitized the blocks from the book *Jo's Floral Album* by Jo Morton for in the hoop appliqué. These blocks are very versatile. Make them country style, modern, or with a limited colour palette. Make the whole quilt to use as a topper or make 3 or 4 blocks into a table runner or foot warmer. Come and perfect your multi-hooping and in the hoop machine embroidery skills in this hands on class. Class fee includes all designs, templates, digital cutting files and cutwork needle files. If you have a hoop that is 200 X 280 mm or bigger then this is a class for you.

<p>Combo Sewing Embroidery Machine with minimum hoop size of 200 X 280 or sewing machine and stand alone embroidery machine with minimum hoop size of 200 X 280 and usual embroidery supplies including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hoop(s) – e-mail me with the make and model of your machine and I will confirm which hoop you must bring for class• Power Cord• Foot control (for sewing the top)• USB stick. Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one. <p>Embroidery foot</p>

<p>Fabric requirements will vary depending on the number of different appliqué fabrics you decide to use. If you wish to create a quilt top with a limited number of colours as I did then you will need to purchase 0.3 m of each fabric. If you use the same colour for all the stems, then purchase 0.5 m. Sashing, border, backing fabric, and batting requirements are the same as in the book.</p>	
<p>Bear Threads Appliqué Pressing Sheet, optional but highly recommended for Edge Cutter users.</p>	
<p>2.0m or more of Wonder Under Fusible Web Note: There are other fusible products available BUT this is the one that works the best with the Edge Cutter and Cutwork Needles or Bernina Cutwork Tool</p>	
<p>Unscented Mary Ellen's Best Press</p>	
<p>505 Temporary Spray</p>	
<p>Machine embroidery thread to coordinate with appliqué fabrics</p>	
<p>Light weight bobbin thread: Decobob or pre-wounds</p>	
<p>Inspira Tear Away Stabilizer</p>	
<p>505 Temporary Spray</p>	
<p>Construction thread for piecing</p>	
<p>Quilting thread</p>	
<p>Janome Blue and Red tip needles.</p>

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to starch all your fabrics for the top.

PREP CLASS

The purpose of the prep class is to review materials and supplies needed for the whole project and to prepare you appliqué fabrics for pre-cutting using the Edge Cutter, Bernina Cutwork Tool or Cutwork needles.

You will need to bring

- **your book,**
- **notebook and pen**
- **as well as your pre starched appliqué fabrics,**
- **Wonder Under Fusible Web,**
- **6 X 12 ruler, rotary cutting mat and rotary cutter,**
- **Pencil.**
