Check with your dealer about availability of a button sewing foot for you machine. <p>Walking Foot with Quilt Guide Bar of Acufeed foot</p>	
<p>0.7 m wide fabric for short pockets and linings (Aqua Dots the photo). 1.4 m fabric for main mat top and backing (Aqua XOX in photo) 0.6 m fabric for tall pockets and thread catcher (Aqua Heart Tiles in photo) 0.5 m solid fabric for short center pocket and decorative stitching panels (White in photo) 0.7 m solid fabric for binding and piping (Red in photo)</p>	
0.7 m of 115 mm wide fusible fleece

0.5 m mid-weight fusible interfacing, such as Decor Bond	
3.0 m 1/8 inch piping cord	
Tear Away Stabilizer	
Two 16 mm (5/8 in) or 20 mm (3/4 in) buttons	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class use please).	
All purpose thread to match	
Matching all purpose thread and embroidery thread in two colours for decorative stitching; two color-matched strands, one of each thread type, are used for all decorative stitching accents	
See-through ruler	
Fabric pen or pencil	
Scissors and/or rotary cutter and mat	
Seam gauge	
Seam ripper	
Straight pins	
Hand sewing needle.	

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to starch all your fabrics for the top.
