- ✓ Shoulder Pads
- √ ¼" wide Steam-a-Seam

P.S. I will have ten jean jackets available to try on. They will be Sandra Betzina's jean jacket pattern (Vogue 7610) in ten sizes (A to J):

- Bust 32" to 55"
- Waist 26 ½" to 50 ½"
- Hip 34 ½" to 57"

If you like Sandra's pattern, make sure you pick it up and bring it to class, and we can do sizing from there. Also if you're working with another pattern for the jean jacket, other than Sandra's pattern, and you're hard to fit, it is best that you show up with a muslin to get a head start on fitting.
