Brief Description of Class: Students in this class will choose which view of Vogue 1598 that they would like to make. There is very little fitting to worry about. Learn how to make a pleated pocket, faced sleeves, hong kong seam finishes, hem facings, piping or facings sewn to look like piping, possible colour blocking, and how to use a multi sized pattern. Class will cover the knowledge and get you started with a bit of sewing at home between sessions.

SUPPLY LIST	
Pattern: Vogue 1598	Our Part #:
Tracing paper to trace out pattern if you want to keep the original intact.	
Ruler, pencil	
Scissors, pins, seam ripper	
Fabric for your project. Choose pattern by bust measurement. Contrast fabric is for facings and pocket insides. Lining is for the inside of pockets.	
Interfacing, Sewer's Dream for light and medium fabrics, Stylemaker for heavier fabrics.	
Buttons, thread, fabric marker that will show on your fabric and is removable	
Piping cord if desired, I used rat tail cord in my jacket. I used .3m of a light knit for my hong kong finishes, use .5m of a light woven if desired. We will discuss this in class.	

Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine
