Brief Description of Class: In this class students will make the Jalie Scoopneck top. They can choose the ruched or pleated neck and make it sleeveless, with tulip sleeves, or longer sleeves. There is an optional bottom band as well. In prep class they will learn about the pattern, find the correct size, trace the pattern onto tracing paper, do some fit checks and cut it out then or at home. The second day will be for sewing it up. They will learn how to construct the front, do a different binding treatment than other Jalie patterns, finish the sleeves and discuss finishing options. Any alterations will be put back on the pattern for future use.
