<p>Combo Sewing/Embroidery Machine or Sewing Machine and Stand Alone Embroidery Machine with standard press foot and usual embroidery supplies including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 200 X 200 mm Hoop• Power Cord• Foot control (for sewing the top)• USB stick. Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.• Embroidery foot

0.6 tone on tone for appliqué background	
0.2 m fabric for pieced sashing (green)	
0.8 m fabric for border	
0.2 m fabric for binding	
1.2 m fabric for backing	
Fabric for appliqués – scraps or fat quarters: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 greens for sepals, stems and leaves' • 2 shades of red for flowers and buds (one of these is also used for the sashing) • 1 colour for flower center 	
0.5 m Wonder Under fusible web or Steam A Seam 2 Sheets	
OESD Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer	
Machine Embroidery thread to coordinate with appliqué fabrics –50 wt Mettler cotton used on sample.	
Machine embroidery bobbin thread or pre-wounds	
Janome Red Tip or 90/14 Machine embroidery needles	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class use please).	
All purpose thread to match	
6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil	
Seam ripper	
Straight pins	
Sharp scissors for pre-cutting appliqué shapes.	
Mini Iron and Press Surface	

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to starch all your fabrics.
