**Thread Painting for Beginners
“Harmony the Hedgehog”**

with Julie

Students will create a cute little Hedgehog using raw edge fusible applique. Free motion thread painting with both straight stitch and zig zag stitch will be used to add realistic detail.

These three techniques work in perfect “Harmony” to help students learn the basics of thread painting.

SUPPLY LIST	
Pattern supplied.	
Fabric; .5 m for background and backing .3 m binding. fat 1/4 or 8 1/2” x 11” piece of a dark medium for hedgehog back and body. Fat 1/4 or 7” x 8” piece of a light medium for hedgehog chest. 2” x 6” piece light medium for hedgehog muzzle and ears. 2” square for nose Scrap for eyes.	
A variety of threads, variegated and plain for thread painting. Try to include dark, medium and light value as well as different weights.	I used 1 50 weight plain and 1 50 weight variegated plus one 30 weight variegated for the back plus 8 light to dark plain and variegated rayon for the chest, muzzle, ears, eyes and nose
1.2 Stylemaker 601 or 602 and /or .6 m Décor Bond	Décor Bond White
1.0 m Wonder Under	Wonder Under
.6 Warm and Natural Batting	
90/14 and 100/16 Topstitch Needles	
Teflon Pressing Sheet	
Marking tools that will be visible on you Hedgehog and background fabrics.	
Darning Foot for machine.	

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Quilting gloves, Quilt Halo Supreme Slider and Extension tray for your machine.	Optional but very helpful.
Pencil and notepad.	

Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order with full accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, scissors, seam ripper, **press sheet**, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.
