

*The Magic Carpet Runner* is based on the Quilt Poetry pattern by the same name. This is an in the hoop appliqué project that features multihooping to create the 12 inch finished appliqué blocks. Simple piecing is used to create the setting triangles. The appliqué design has been digitized exclusively for Snip and Stitch Sewing Centre. Pick your favourite border fabric and coordinating fabrics to make your own Magic Carpet Runner. Learn all about appliqué fabric preparation, stabilizing, multi-hooping and simple finishing techniques. This class is also suitable for the Large Oval Bernina hoop. Suitable for beginners. All embroidery designs, appliqué patterns and instructions are included in the class fee.

<p><b>Combo Sewing/Embroidery Machine or Sewing Machine and Stand Alone Embroidery Machine Usual embroidery supplies including</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Bernina Large Oval Hoop</b></li> <li>• <b>Power Cord</b></li> <li>• <b>Foot control (for sewing the top)</b></li> <li>• <b>USB stick.</b> Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.</li> <li>• <b>Embroidery foot</b></li> </ul>

0.4 m light green for appliqué and piecing	
0.2 m or scrap navy blue for applique	
0.2 m or scrap yellow for piecing	
0.4 m red for inner border	
0.4 m light teal for applique	
0.5 m print for outer border	
0.2 m for binding	
1.5 m backing	
30 X 60 in piece batting	
1.0 m Wonder Under fusible web if you will be cutting your appliqué pieces with a digital cutter.	
Bear Threads Appliqué Pressing Sheet, optional but highly recommended for <u>Edge Cutter</u> users. This is not needed if you will be pre-cutting your appliqué shapes with scissors.	
Quilters Select Appli-Stick Printer Sheets or OESD Appliqué Fuse and Fix Sheets These help you cut your appliqué shapes with scissors more accurately than tracing because I can run them through a printer for you	
Machine embroidery thread to coordinate with appliqué fabrics	
Decobob or pre-wounds	
Inspira Tear Away Stabilizer or OESD Ultra Clean and Tear	
Mary Ellens' Best Press (unscented for class use please)	
505 Temporary Spray	
Construction thread for piecing	
Quilting thread	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	
6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil	
Seam ripper

Sharp scissors for pre-cutting appliqué shapes, such as Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Scissors Medium 6 in – Blue (highly recommended).	
Mini Iron and Press Surface if using Wonder Under Fusible Web	
¼ inch foot	
Janome Blue (75/11) and Red Tip (90/14) Machine embroidery needles	
Your own 6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil that will show up on your fabrics	
Thread Snips	

### **PREP-CLASS**

**Do not bring your embroidery machine or embroidery supplies to this class.**

**If you are hand cutting your appliqué shapes also bring your printable fusible web sheets, small sharp scissors, pencil, rotary cutter, mat and ruler. Once I have printed your appliqué patterns on your fusible web sheets you can begin cutting out the appliqué shapes.**

**If you are using a digital cutter to cut your appliqué shapes bring your starched and pressed appliqué fabrics and WonderUnder Fusible Web. Also bring a rotary cutter, mat and ruler. You will be measuring and fusing the WonderUnder to the wrong side of your fabrics in preparation for cutting at home. If you need help using your cutter you will need to sign up for a Machine Embroidery Software Cafe. No time allowance is provided in this class for cutting your fabrics with a digital cutter.**
