The Villa Rosa Blueberry Cobbler Table Runner pattern lends itself beautifully to quilting with rulers. Come enjoy the fun as we construct and quilt this lovely runner.

Students will learn basic rotary cutting and piecing skills plus free motion ruler quilting.

Sewing machine with all accessories including foot control and power cord, ¼ inch piecing foot, Ruler Foot and extension tray.	A variety of free motion rulers suitable to your machine. Those that can spin around a central point are especially fun for this project
Pattern; Blueberry Cobbler from Villa Rosa Designs	
100% cotton fabric This pattern can be cut from 2 charm packs or fat ¼'s I used yardage for mine to make the colors a little more controlled. .2 M each of four darks and four lights will give you plenty of extra to play with. 1.1 M for backing .3 M for binding	In total you will need ; 48 dark 2 ½” squares 48 light 2 ½” squares 24 light 4 ½” squares 2 border pieces 2 ½” by 6 ½” .3 m for binding (4 strips 2 ½” x WOF)
.6 m low loft batting such as Warm and Natural or Hobbs 80/20	
50 weight cotton thread for piecing. Thread for quilting in a color to blend with or contrast with your fabric	
Quilters marking tool that is clearly visible on your chosen fabric. Please test prior to class to be sure that this will both mark well and remove easily.	
Westalee 8 point Crosshair Ruler	
Westalee Spacing Gauge WA-SPG	

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Curved Quilting Needle (Hand)	
Quilting gloves	Sewing tweezers

Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order with full accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: **Rotary cutter, ruler & mat**, scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.
