Bernette Knit Fabric hands on serger garment class

Brief Description of Class: Students will make a knit tunic length vest using serger techniques. Free pattern from Bernette.com will be used. Learn how to adjust the pattern, cut out, and construct using serger, home sewing machine, and coverstitch options.

SUPPLY LIST	Our Part #:
Pattern: free pattern from Bernette.com must be downloaded and printed at home before class as well as the instructions	
Fabric- 1.2m for size 36-38 or 1.8m for size 40-46, 150cm wide	
4 serger threads to match fabric	
1, decorative-contrast-or wooly poly thread for accent stitching. We will discuss at prep class	
Pattern tracing paper to trace out size and make adjustments	
Fabric marker-air erase or chalkoliner	
Optional-stay tape or 1/4" twill tape to stabilize shoulder seams	
Scissors, pins, seam ripper, small ruler	

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine. Serger with manual and accessories.
Optional Coverstitch machine for hems with manual

Homework prior to class (if applicable): Go to Bernette.com/projects and download the pattern and instructions for the project before the prep class. In the prep class we will trace it in the correct size and add the seam allowances so you will then be able to cut it out before the 2nd class. Also, prewashing your fabric is advised.
