



**Multi-hooping lets you create designs larger than your embroidery hoop. In this one day hands on class with Donna stitch out a 14 inch trim-in-place appliqué design suitable for a pillow top or stitch more designs after class to create a table runner. Suitable for machines with a Bernina Oval Hoop and the Bernette 79 Large Hoop. Also suitable for all other brands of machines with larger hoops. Class fee includes designs used in class.**

<p><b>Combo Sewing/Embroidery Machine or Sewing Machine and Stand Alone Embroidery Machine with usual embroidery supplies including</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>All your hoops for your machine.</b></li> <li>• <b>Power Cord</b></li> <li>• <b>USB stick.</b> Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.</li> <li>• <b>Embroidery foot</b></li> </ul>	

0.5 m fabric for embroidery background and pillow back	
3 coordinating fabrics for appliqué shapes 0.2 m or fat quarters	
0.5 m Wonder Under Fusible Web (optional but creates a stronger appliqué fabric).	
Inspira Tear Away OR OESD Clean and Tear

505 Temporary Spray	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class)	
Applique Pressing Sheet	
3 or more coordinating embroidery thread colours	
Decobob and empty bobbins or pre-wounds	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles or Schmetz Embroidery needles	
6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil	
Seam ripper	
Straight pins	
Small curved, sharp scissors for cutting appliqué in the hoop – Havel's Snip Ease highly recommended.	
Mini Iron and Press Surface	
Other sewing/embroidery supplies you like to use.	

### **PRE-CLASS PREPARATION**

**Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to starch all your fabrics.**

**From your fabric for embroidery background cut a 16 inch square.**
