Multiple Spool holder (optional, but if you have one bring it!)	
Machine tools (screw driver, brush, etc.)	
Stylus	
Machine Manual	
Small embroidery scissors or snips	
Four 10 X 14 inch rectangles plain or tone on tone fabric – light in colour	
OESD Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer	
505 Temporary Spray Adhesive	
USB stick (2 gigabytes or smaller) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If your machine came with a Bernina USB stick, please bring it.</li><li>• If you have purchased a USB stick, please test in your machine to be sure your machine can read what is on the stick. Not all brands of USB sticks are compatible with the software in embroidery machines.</li></ul>	
Assorted colours Machine Embroidery Threads (the ones that came with your machine are fine).

Decobob machine embroidery bobbin thread and an empty bobbin	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class use please)	
Removable Marking pen that will show up on your fabrics. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I highly recommend the Sewline Water Soluble Pen.</li></ul>	
Schmetz Embroidery needles or Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	

### **PRE-CLASS PREPARATION**

**Space in the classroom is limited. Please ensure you prepare your fabric at home.**

- Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to press fabric for embroidery at home. Spray and iron dry 2 or 3 times. This takes the "shrink" out of the fabric and will improve the quality of your embroidery stitch out.
