Snip & Stitch



Scrap Tee

Brief Description of Class: Learn how to use all those knit scraps that are not big enough for a garment in this class. Different serger stitches are used to piece together a piece of fabric which is then cut out for the pattern. Pattern used is the Marceau Tee by The Sewing Workshop. Other pieces can be colour blocked or one fabric. The pattern has offset neck and hemlines, pleats in the two piece sleeves, and cuffs at the wrist. This is a great way to upcycle your stash. 3 and 4 thread serger stitches, flatlock stitch, neck binding, and blindstitch on serger will be covered. You can bring your regular machine as well.

SUPPLY LIST	
Pattern: Marceau Tee	Our Part #: TSWPP074
Fabrics for project: scrap knits of various types. A .7m would be enough to cut a whole front, back, or sleeve piece. There are guidelines on back of pattern (but add scraps)	
Serger thread, regular and wooly poly, can match or contrast	
Ruler, cutter, mat, scissors, seam ripper, press cloth, tracing paper,	
Measuring tape	
Stretch needle if you will be using your regular machine for binding or hems, we will discuss in the prep class	
Optional: stay tape for shoulder seams	
Fabric marker, pins	

Bring serger with manual and accessories.

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine. We will discuss options in the prep class.
