



***Glamorous Clams* by Deborah Louie is your complete step-by-step guide to mastering decorative-stitch appliqué using your sewing machine. Get started on making a cushion or wall hanging. While the book is written for Bernina machines, the techniques and skills covered, apply to all brands of machines with decorative stitches. Filled with clear instructions and wonderful photographs, the book comes with templates to make tracing the different parts of the clams easy.**

<p>Sewing machine with a range of decorative stitches. All the feet that came with your machine, including decorative stitch feet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Bernina: 20, 20C or 20D, 34C, 39C• Husqvarna: B foot – open and closed• Janome: F foot – open and closed <p>If your machine used a freehand or knee lift, also bring it.</p>

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My small sample was made with one package of 5 inch charm squares. A charm pack has 42 squares. If you want to use fabric on hand, cut an assortment of 5 inch squares, 42 or more in total.	
Backing and batting	
Tear Away Stabilizer	
2 pieces white fabric cut into 8 X 11 inch rectangles for test stitch outs.	
Wonder Under fusible web	
Machine embroidery threads to coordinate with appliqué fabrics	
Decobob or prewounds	
505 Temporary Spray	
Construction thread for piecing	
Quilting thread	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	
6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil	
Regular pen or fine point sharpy	
Seam ripper	
Straight pins	
Sharp scissors for cutting appliqué shapes, such as Karen Kay Buckley's Perfect Scissors Medium 6 in – Blue (highly recommended).	
Appliqué pressing sheet	
Fabric pen or pencil that will show up on your fabrics	
Thread Snips	

This is a technique class, not a finished project class. The purpose of the class is to help you learn the decorative stitch functions of your machine while making a fun clam shell sample.
