Donna has digitized Quilt Poetry's "Promenade Redux" for in the hoop machine appliqué. . Once the embroidery is complete, easy piecing completes the runner for you to quilt as desired. Learn all about trim in the hoop appliqué and multi-hooping. Suitable for Bernina Embroidery machines with a Maxi Hoop or Jumbo Hoop. Also suitable for Husqvarna/Pfaff machines with a 200 X 360 Hoop or larger and Janome machines with a 200 X 280 hoop or larger.

If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.• Embroidery foot

<p>Fabric Requirements vary slightly from that on the pattern and are what you need to make the table runner:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 0.5 m beige tone on tone • 0.5 m dark beige tone on tone • 0.6 m brown/gray mix (includes binding) • 0.4 m midnight navy • 0.2 m blue/green mix • 0.6 m backing fabric 	
22 X 38 inch piece of batting	
1.2 m Wonder Under fusible web	
Bear Threads Appliqué Pressing Sheet or similar	
Machine Embroidery Threads to coordinate with appliqué fabrics	
Decobob and empty bobbins or pre-wounds	
Inspira Tear Away Stabilizer	
505 Temporary Spray	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class please)	
Construction thread for piecing	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	
Fabric marker that will show up on your fabric (test before use to make sure you can remove it)	
Paper scissors or old rotary cutter blade, ruler, mat	
Basic sewing supplies including: Seam Ripper, Thread Snips,	
Thread snips	
Eyelet cutter	
Scotch tape	
¼ inch foot	
Walking foot or Accufeed Flex Foot	
Mini Iron and Press Surface	

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PRE-CLASS PREP

If you pre-wash your fabrics, do not use any fabric softener or dryer sheets. These interfere with the bond between your fabric and Wonder Under fusible web.

Please treat all fabrics with one or two good coats of Mary Ellen's Best Press. Spray and iron dry.

PREP CLASS

The purpose of the prep class is to ensure that all participants have the appropriate supplies needed to complete the project. There will be time to purchase any supplies you may not have on hand.

I will go over the process of Multi-Hooping and explain how some of the original pattern instructions are changed to accommodate the Multi-Hooping process. We will also prepare your full-scale positioning template.

Bring the following supplies to the Prep Class:

- All fabrics, already treated with Mary Ellen's Best Press if possible.
- Wonder Under Fusible Web
- Bear Threads Appliqué Pressing Sheet or similar
- The Hoops that come with your machine
- Ruler, Rotary Cutter with old blade or Paper Scissors, Scotch tape.
- Pen or Pencil

I do my best to ensure the supply list is complete. If you think I have left something out, please bring it.
