Ron Collins' 3 Day Ultimate Retreat

Brief Description of Class: This is an open project workshop meaning that students can work on whatever they want (except jeans, which is a separate workshop on its own). The patterns you choose do not have to be from the major pattern companies (Vogue/ Butterick/McCall's). They can also be from smaller independent pattern companies (example: Jalie/Closet Core).

Students work on tops, jackets, knit tops, dress pants, whether in woven or stretch woven and knits fabrics. In some cases students prefer to work on one project or others prefer to be helped on several garments to various stages; the choice is up to you!

The workshop starts out determining your pattern size and making fitting adjustments to the pattern before the garment is cut out in muslin.

Please bring any notions that are required for the garment (which is stated on the back on the envelope).

For example:

- Garment Fabric (pre-washed)
- Pattern
- Muslin Fabric
- Lining
- Interfacing
- Buttons/Closure
- Thread
- Shoulder Pads
- Stay tape
- Zipper

Please bring the following:

Sewing machine in good working order and all accessory feet Serger in good working order (if you have one) Thread for Serger Machine needles appropriate for your fabric choice Scissors for fabric and paper Tape Tissue paper All basic sewing notions; for example:

- Pins
- Sewing Gauge
- Marking Pen
- Seam ripper
- Point turner
