Spring Jacket

Brief Description of Class: Using Kwik Sew Pattern 3732 students will make an unlined spring jacket. Suitable for beginners but will have a few extra techniques covered as options. Learn how to trace and cut the pattern, apply interfacing, construct facings, insert sleeves, make buttonholes, and hem. Options include adding flat piping, different seam finishes, pattern matching, and patch pockets. Choose to make the shorter or longer jacket, optional pockets, and whether or not you want a collar.

SUPPLY LIST	
Pattern: Kwik Sew 3732	Our Part #:
Fabric as required on pattern back. If the fabric is 52" wide go with the 45" listing. Choose pattern size by full bust measurement.	
Interfacing, shapeflex or Suitmaker 601 as listed for your size.	
Buttons, thread	
Optional: .5m if making piping, .6m of cotton or lightweight lining if you want to do hong kong seam finishes, look at the sample. Pocket pressing template if making patch pockets	

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, Scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins, thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.

Homework prior to class (if applicable): Prewash and press your fabric in the same way that you will launder the finished garment.
