90/14 Topstitch Needles	
Westalee 8 point Crosshair Ruler Westalee Stable Tape WA-ST	Westalee Spacing Gauge WA-SPG Westalee Stitching Line Disc Set WA-SLD
Fabric 100% cotton in a solid colour or tone on tone 1.5 m each of two different fabrics 3.0 m if using a single fabric 1.0 m for sashing (front and back) and binding	Quilters marking tool that is clearly visible on your chosen fabric. Please test prior to class to be sure that this will both mark well and remove easily.
.8 m Warm and Natural Batting Or Hobbs Heirloom 80/20 (Fusible)	Westalee Ruler Foot Echo Guides WA-WFEG or correct Echo feet to fit your machine
505 Spray (optional)	Westalee Outer Rim Tool WA-CWOR

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Curved Quilting Needle (Hand)	
50 weight cotton thread to contrast with your fabric for quilting. 50 weight cotton thread to match your sashing fabric	FROG Tape (Hardware store)
Quilting Gloves	Sewing tweezers

Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order with full accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.

Prior to Class

From each 1.5 m of fabric cut four 14” strips.

Cut three 14” squares from each strip.

You will have twelve 14” squares of each fabric.

Cut your batting into twelve 14” squares.

Bring all pieces to class.
