The pattern "Fat Quarter Shuffle" is a great quilt top to learn all about endless quilting on your embroidery machine. Make the crib size in Layout A and use the provided quilting design to learn how to use your Pin Point Placement on your Bernina Embroidery Machine or Design Positioning on your Husqvarna or Pfaff Embroidery Machine. Also suitable for Janome 12000, 15000, 500E and 550E with optional Acufil Quilting Hoop.

<p>Combo Sewing/Embroidery Machine or Sewing machine and Embroidery Only Machine, power cord and foot control.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• ¼ inch foot for piecing at Prep Class• We will discuss what hoops and other embroidery supplies you will need at the prep class as this will vary depending on brand of machine• USB stick. Please make sure your USB stick works in your machine! With rapidly changing technology it is impossible for me to predict what size or Brand of USB stick will work in various machines. If your machine did come with a USB stick, bring that one.

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Fabric for making Crib Size, Layout A as listed on the pattern: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 10 fat quarters (each, 18 X 21in)• 3.0 m backing fabric (piece horizontally)• 0.5 m binding fabric• 55 X 65 piece of batting (1.5 m)	
Construction thread for piecing	
Quilting thread (same thread used on top and in the bobbin.	
Janome Blue and Red tip needles.	
6 X 24 ruler, mat and rotary cutter.	
Fabric pen or pencil that shows up on your fabrics	
Seam ripper	
Straight pins	
Thread Snips	

PREP CLASS

The purpose of the prep class is to get you started on piecing the crib-size quilt top so that you will have your quilt sandwich ready for the next class.

Bring your 10 fat quarters, rotary cutter, cutting mat and rotary cutting ruler.

Also bring a sewing machine with ¼ inch foot, foot control and power cord. You should also bring basic sewing tools such as pins, seam ripper, etc.
