Come and learn how to make the beautiful Ribbons & Bows Galore wholecloth quilt. You will learn how to create a variety of designs suitable for quilting blocks, borders and background fil. Finishing at approximately 32” x 41” this little quilt is the ideal size to top a table or bed, pop over your lap while you read your favourite book or snuggle a special new baby.  
Simply add borders to make it bed sized

<p>DM Quilting Basic Marking Tool 4” x 12” Or 12” x 12” OR Any quilting ruler with clear 1” lines</p>	
<p><b>Westalee Stable Tape WA-ST</b></p>	
<p><b>Westalee Spacing Gauge WA-SPG</b></p>	
<p><b>Ruler Foot for your machine.</b></p>	
<p>Pattern Ribbons &amp; Bows Galore <b>DMRIBBONS</b></p>	<p><b>Quilters marking tool that is clearly visible on your chosen fabric. Please test prior to class to be sure that this will both mark well and remove easily.</b></p>

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<p><b>Fabric</b>                  2.2 m will do the front back and binding of the small quilt (32" x 41")                  If you would like the front and back to be different you will need the following:                  .9 m for the front                  1.0 m for the back                  .2 m for the binding</p>	<p>Additional fabric will be required if you wish to add borders.                   A 12" minimum test sandwich of a front fabric, backing and batting.                  I purchased 2.5 m of my chosen fabric so that I would have a little extra to test my machine settings and thread choices.</p>
<p>Supreme Slider or Free Motion Glider</p>	
<p>Quilting gloves (Optional but helpful)</p>	
<p>80/12 and 90/14 Topstitch needles                  Curved Quilting Needle (hand)</p>	
<p>1.0 m or (38" x 47") low loft batting</p>	
<p>50 weight cotton thread (or heavier), or thread of your choice for quilting.                  50 weight cotton thread for bag assembly.</p>	<p><b>Note:</b>                  Do not try and match your thread colour too closely to your fabric.                  If using the same colour it should be a shade or two lighter or darker. We want to see your quilting!</p>

**Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order with full accessories, Ruler Foot, Extension Tray, Foot Control & manual for machine.**

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.

- When borders or medallion units are joined together with quilting, a large decorative quilt can easily be created.
- For best results, some experience with quilting techniques is helpful but not required.
