This class is designed to help you master the embroidery functions of your Bernina 500, 570QEE, 590, 700, 770's, 790Plus, or 880Plus machine and will cover the basics of set up, stabilizers, hooping techniques, combining designs and on board editing. This is a full day guide lesson for our owners. Special pricing for all others.

Machine and embroidery module.	
Power cord.	
Teardrop embroidery foot #26.	
Large oval hoop.	
Plastic hoop template with clips.	
Straight stitch plate <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 570 QEE bring your 9 mm plate if you do not have a straight stitch plate	
Multiple Spool holder (optional, but if you have one, bring it!).	
Machine tools (screw driver, brush, etc.).	
Stylus.	
Machine manual.	
Small embroidery scissors or snips.	
Four 10 X 15 inch rectangles plain or tone on tone fabric – light in colour. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please pre-treat with a couple of coats of Mary Ellen's Best Press or other starch to take the shrink out of your fabric.	
OESD Ultra Clean and Tear Stabilizer.	
505 temporary spray adhesive.	

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USB stick (2 gigabytes or smaller) <ul style="list-style-type: none">• If your machine came with a Bernina USB stick, please bring it.• If you have purchased a USB stick, please test in your machine to be sure your machine can read what is on the stick. Not all brands of USB sticks are compatible with the software in embroidery machines. We do sell USB sticks that will work in your machine.	
Assorted colours machine embroidery threads (the ones that came with your machine are fine).	
Neutral colour Decobob machine embroidery bobbin thread and an empty bobbin.	
Mary Ellen's Best Press (unscented for class use please).	
Removable Marking pen that will show up on your fabrics. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• I highly recommend the Sewline Water Soluble Pen.	
Schmetz embroidery needles or Janome blue and red tip needles.	

PRE-CLASS PREPARATION

Space in the classroom is limited. **Please ensure you prepare your fabric at home.**

- Use Mary Ellen's Best Press to press fabric for embroidery at home. Spray and iron dry 2 or 3 times. This takes the "shrink" out of the fabric and will improve the quality of your embroidery stitch out.

I do my best to ensure the supply list is complete. If you think I have left something out, please bring it.
