GOING IN CIRCLES - FALL 2023

Explore decorative stitch techniques and learn how to use your circular sewing attachment while creating a designer runner. Start with shades of your favourite colour and decorate each block with embroidery thread and decorative stitches. After piecing the top and sandwiching with batting and backing, use free motion or walking foot quilting to enhance your runner. A fun class for any brand of machine with decorative stitches.

Please bring to class your sewing machine, power cord and foot control. See the list of specific feet below. If you are not sure if you have these feet, bring all the feet you have!

If you do not own a Circular Sewing Attachment for your machine, please **consult with staff right a way** so we can be sure to have the one for your brand and type of machine in time for class. To help us, you need to tell us the brand and specific model of your machine. We **only have access to parts for Janome, Husqvarna, and Bernina.**

Your manual.

Extra bobbins.

Notebook and pen.

Three 0.2 m cuts of fabric, a light, medium and medium dark.

0.8 metres fabric for borders, backing and fold over binding.

0.5 m Pellon fusible batting.

Circular sewing attachment compatible with machine.

Variety of threads to compliment fabric colour, including metallic thread and variegated threads, if desired.

OESD Ultra Clean and Tear.

Mary Ellens Best Press.

505 temporary spray.

Machine embroidery needles.

Decobob pre-wounds or Decobob on the spool for winding your own bobbin.

Open toe decorative stitch foot.

¼ inch patchwork foot.

Walking foot.

This class will focus on the decorative aspects of using a circular stitcher on your machine. If you wish to finish the top into a table runner, you will also need batting and backing as listed in the supplies.
