Make The Most of Your Rotary Rulers - Level II

Improve your rotary cutting and sewing skills as you learn how to cut and piece a series of three different quilt blocks. You will learn how to read a pattern to determine the easiest cutting order, method and rulers to use as well as lots of tips and tricks for perfecting your quarter inch seam allowance.

Instructions will be given to assemble your blocks into an optional table runner after class.

45 mm rotary cutter, 24" ruler 6" (or larger) square and cutting mat	
Fabric .5 m focus fabric (Includes the table runner border.) One fat ¼ or .2 m accent #1 One fat ¼ or .2 m accent #2 .6 m background .3 m for binding 1.0 m for backing (not needed for class) 26" x 52" low loft batting (Not needed for class)	Note If you do not wish to assemble your blocks into a table runner than you will need .2 or one fat ¼ of each of your main fabrics and .5 m of background.
50 weight cotton thread in a colour to blend with your fabrics for piecing.	
75/11 Quilting or 80/12 Microtex needles	
Notebook and Pen	

Sewing Machine: please bring machine to class in good working order with ¼" piecing foot, spare bobbins, all accessories & manual for machine.

Basic Sewing Supplies: scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, straight pins thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.
