Brief Description of Class: Using Jalie Pattern 2805 students will make a basic t-shirt. Choose crew neck, V neck, mock turtleneck, or henley neck. Choose any sleeve length. Learn how to trace a multi sized pattern, how to cut out the fabric, how to use your machine and or serger to get great results, neckline finishes, and hem options. Learn what needles and notions help get the job done.

SUPPLY LIST	
Pattern: Jalie 2805	Our Part #:
Pattern tracing paper or red dot tracing material	
Pen and ruler for tracing pattern	
Fabric as listed on pattern back, contact me if you have questions about this, it must be knit fabric	
Stretch 75/11 needle for machine	
1/4" steam a seam	
Fabric marker that will show on your fabric	
Rotary cutter, pins, seam ripper, scissors	
Thread to match (if using a serger, 4 cones of serger thread)	

Sewing Machine: Please bring machine to class in good working order, bring all accessories & manual for machine. You can sew the tee on a serger but will still need your regular machine. Directions will be given for sewing machine version and serger version.

Machines not needed in the first class.

Homework prior to class (if applicable): Prewash your fabric the same way as you will when the garment is complete.
