

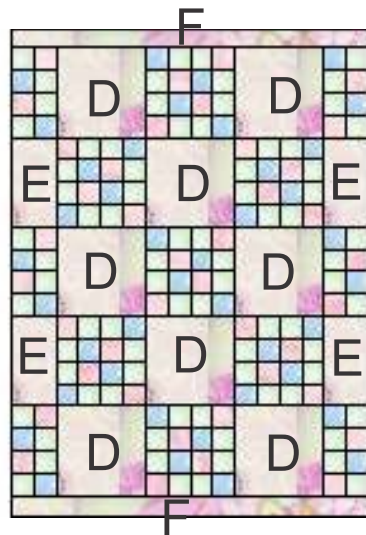
Project: Cross Roads Pregnancy Centre Quilt (2025)

This quilt finishes about 36 X 48 inches.

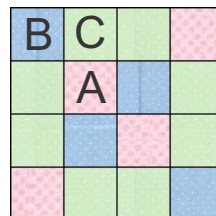
Quilts need batting, backing and should have some quilting.

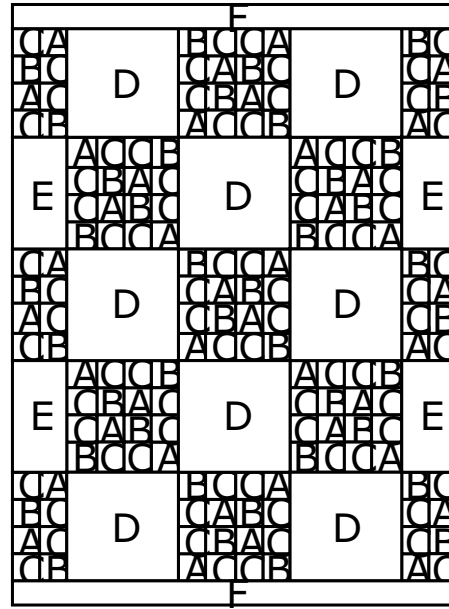
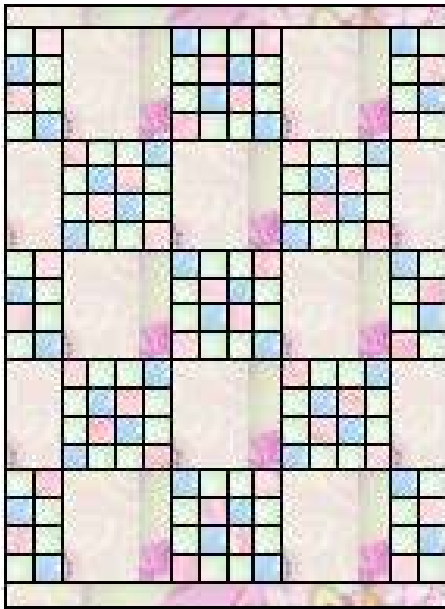

Cut 6 - 2 3/4 in. wide strips



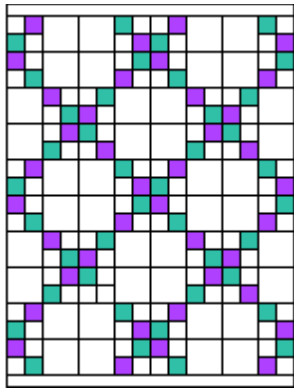
Cut 2 - 9 1/2 in. wide strips
Cut 8 squares



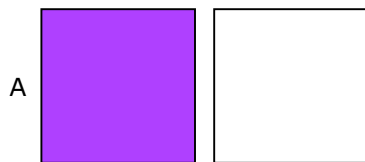
Cut 1 - 5 in. wide strip
Cut 4 rectangles 9 1/2 in. long



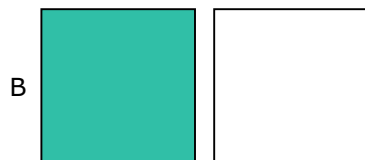
Cut 2 - 2 1/2 in. wide strips

Also cut 5 strips, 2 inches X wof for binding



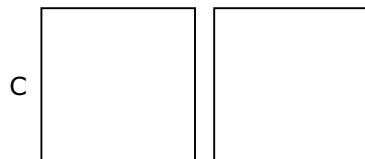

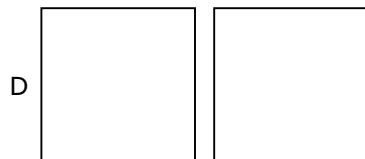
Cut 40 2 3/4 in. squares if using scraps



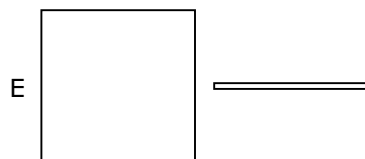
Cut 40 2 3/4 in. squares if using scraps



Cut 80 2 3/4 in. squares if using scraps



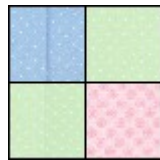
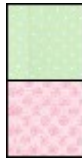
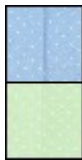
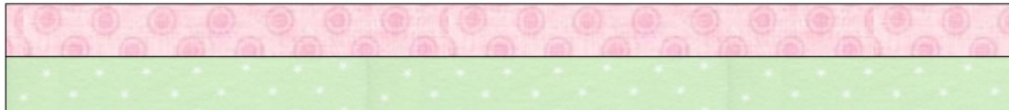
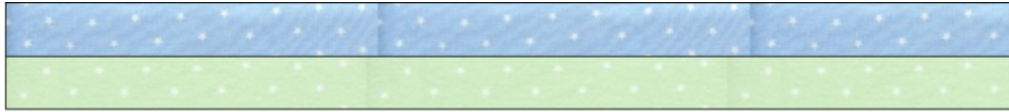
Cut 40 5 in. squares if using scraps



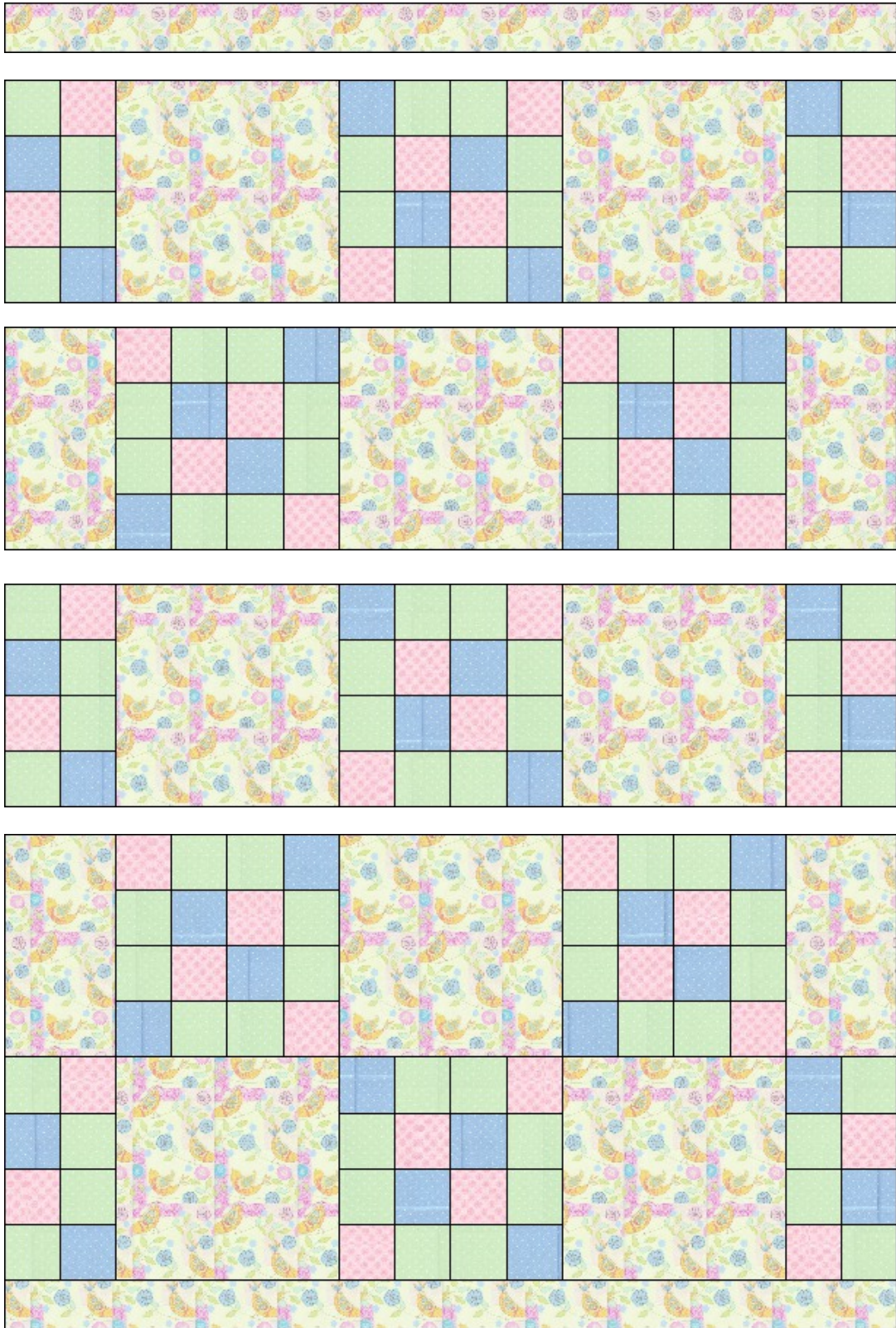
Cut 2 - 2 in. wide strips
Cut 2 rectangles 36 1/2 in. long for top and bottom border
Also cut 5 strips, 2 inches X wof for binding

Yardage Instructions.

Create strip sets using Colours A, B, and C using $\frac{1}{4}$ in. seams.
Subcut each strip set into 40 - $2\frac{3}{4}$ in. segments.
Create 80 - 4 patch units.

to orientation of colours in the 4 patches.
Piece using 1/4 in seams.
