Bohemian Carpet Bag (aka Mary Poppins Bag) NEW

with Brenda

Learn basic bag making techniques including installing pocket zippers, slip pockets, strap making, boxing corners and hardware installation. In the first class we will cover fabric and interfacing/stabilizing options, pocket style decisions, customizing to suit your needs and we will cut and prep all the pieces for the bag. The second class we will put it all together and install the hardware.

Bohemian Carpet Bag by Sew Liberated	Paper scissors for cutting out pattern and fabric scissors for cutting fabric
16" Hinged Tubular Frame	Sewing clips; optional 1/8" double sided tape
Purse Feet	1/4" foot, zipper or narrow foot
Approx. 1/4" corrugated plastic or foam board (7 x 17) and optional 1/2" foam (7 x 17)	50 wt thread to match exterior and lining fabrics (40 wt cotton or polyester is also fine)
1.3 m each of fusible fleece and SF101 or other similar interfacing	16" Tubular frame
7" and 10" co-ordinating zippers – size 3, 4.5 or 5 will work – a 20" double pull handbag zipper will do both or zipper tape with 2 pulls	Sewing Machine: Please bring your machine to class in good working order with full accessories & manual for the machine.
Exterior Fabric – 1/3 m of heavy fabric such as denim, light weight canvas, upholstery fabric. If using quilt weight cotton you will need to double the amount of SF101. Accent & Handle Fabric – 1 m (can be made using quilting cotton, flannel, cork, faux leather, wool, canvas, corduroy). Lining Fabric – 1.5 m to co-ordinate with exterior fabric	Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.
