When learning how to machine quilt, we often practice on small projects or squares of fabric.

Let's have some fun learning how to free motion quilt an actual quilt! Students will learn a variety of easy-to-stitch free motion quilting designs, then use their new skills to quilt Nevada, from Villa Rosa Designs, with lots of tips and tricks along the way.

Pattern; Nevada from Villa Rosa Designs	
Fabric Six fat ¼'s Binding: .5m	Note So that we can concentrate on the quilting process, please piece and layer your quilt before coming to class. If you need help with this, you might also like to sign up for a UFO.
1.2 m Backing	
42" x 51" low loft batting	
50-weight cotton thread for piecing	
Thread for quilting (we will discuss this in class on an individual basis)	
Sharp needles as appropriate to your thread. A selection to have on hand would be 75/11 and 90/14 Quilting, 90/14 Topstitch Janome Red or purple Tip	
A sketchbook, pen and pencil.	

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Sewing Machine: Please bring your machine to class in good working order with full accessories, a Darning Foot (FMQ), extra bobbins, foot control & manual for the machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.
