Take a Stand by annie (small size bag) NEW

with Brenda

A great bag that uses many standard bag making techniques including binding made easy. Keep in mind when buying fabric that you may want to make the large one as well to match the small one we will be making (the large bag is designed to accommodate both the small bag and the Running with Scissors by annie). There will be a complete set of all 3 at class for you to see.

Take A Stand by annie pattern (Snip & Stitch will have it)	Zippers – follow instructions in the pattern for small sized bag. I use 4.5 or 5 zipper tape by the yd.
Exterior Fabric - .8 m quilting cotton	1" hardware: 2 D-rings, 2 swivel hooks & 1 slider (strap adjuster)
Lining Fabric – 1m (incl. enough for substituting cotton for mesh pocket)	¼" foot, zipper
Co-ordinating/Contrasting Fabric – .8 m for binding, straps and zipper pulls. 2.3 m. of nylon webbing. Optional – 2.5 m of polypro 1" strapping (nylon webbing) – this is more than pattern says if you want to skip the fabric sleeve and strap tabs and use only webbing as in class sample. The pattern calls for making fabric sleeves that you thread the webbing into – if you wish to skip the sleeve just get a little more webbing.	50 or 40b wt co-ordinating thread cotton or polyester. Also thread that is a good match to your zippers.
Foam interfacing – 18" x 58"	Fold-over elastic – 1 pkg and 1 pkg co-ordinating or contrasting mesh (instead of mesh you can use quilting cotton (24 x 26) to match or co-ordinate with lining
Fusible interfacing – SF101 or med. Weight fusible interfacing - .25 m	

Sewing Machine: Please bring your machine to class in good working order with full accessories & manual for the machine.

Basic Sewing Kit: Rotary cutter, ruler & mat, scissors, seam ripper, press sheet, pins (safety and straight), thread, thread snips, fabric marker of choice.
