Brief Description of Class: In this class you will make the Archer Button Up Top from Grainline Studio. You will learn the sewing techniques that patterns don't always include in their instructions. These include which interfacings to use, how to do precise edgestitching and topstitching, how to turn small collar points, cuff plackets, collar stands, buttonholes and more.

Pattern: Archer Button Up	Our Part #:
Fabric as listed on the pattern for your size	
Pattern tracing paper, pencil or fine line Sharpie marker, small ruler	
Interfacing, Sewer's Dream or fusiknit	
Thread to match your fabric	
Hand sewing needle	
Buttons for your chosen view	
Fabric marker	
Scissors, seam ripper, small snips, pressing cloth	
Buttonhole cutter	
Fray check	

Sewing Machine: Please Bring machine to class in good working order, bring full accessories & manual for your machine. You won't need your machine for the first class. Bring the following feet if you have them: buttonhole foot, button sewing foot, edge joining or ditch quilting foot, 1/4" foot.

Homework prior to class (if applicable): Prewash your fabric in the same way as you will launder the completed garment.
